- Does my host operating system **AND** the service comply with the applicable [baseline configurations](#)?
- Could this service run on a dedicated server or virtual machine (**NOT** a desktop or other general business computing machine)?
- If offering authenticated access, does the service abide by the [FNAL Authentication policies](#) and utilize central authentication (such as KCA certificates or LDAP)?
- Does my operating system **AND** this service send theird logs to the CST Central Syslog service?
