


## Getting Connected With VMWare View For Windows

You should already have the VMWare View client installed on your computer.  
If you do not, please contact the Service Desk.

You may launch the VMWare View client in one of two ways:



- 1) Via the start menu, by clicking  
Start->VMWare->VMware View Client

In the 'Connection Server' field, enter:  
**view.fnal.gov**  
Then, click 'Connect'



- 2) Alternatively, you can open a web browser and browse to <https://view.fnal.gov>


You should then be presented with a friendly logon banner.  
Read it thoroughly, then click 'Continue'




Enter your SERVICES username and password

You should then be presented with a list of the Virtual Desktops you are authorized to use.

Select the desktop you wish to connect to and click 'Connect'.




## Getting Connected With VMWare View For Windows



You should be connected to your VMWare View Desktop.

At the top of the screen is the menu ribbon. Log on by sending a CTRL-ALT-DELETE via the options menu.

Since seeing the Fermi logon banner just once is never enough, we show it to you again. Click 'OK'



Now, enter your FERMI username and password, and press the 'enter', or 'return' key.

You should now be logged into your VMware View Desktop
